



Tim Hecht Scholarship Program

A Memorial to All Fallen Law Enforcement Officers of Porter County, Indiana

**All requests for consideration must be received by May 31, 2022.
No application form is used.**

1. OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this program is to provide financial assistance to worthy students who have an interest in a law enforcement career after receiving post-secondary education. The major factors in evaluating applicants are career objective, financial need and the insight gained from the letter written by applicants requesting consideration.

2. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Applicant maintained an overall “C” or better grade average during the past two school years.
- B. Applicant must intend to choose Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement, Pre-Law or other similar course of study as a “major” or primary area of study.
- C. Applicant must be a Senior attending a high school in Porter County, Indiana

3. REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- A. A typed letter in which the applicant will discuss the following subjects:
 - 1. Why he/she wants to pursue a career in law Enforcement.
 - 2. Hobbies, interests and personal achievements.
 - 3. Career objectives- short and long term.
 - 4. Name of school, college or university applicant plans to attend and why chosen.
 - 5. Relative importance of financial assistance.
- B. A transcript of school records.
- C. Two letters of recommendation (other than a relative). One must be a teacher.
- D. A copy of a Letter of Acceptance from the intended school.
